Interlocking Astragal Magnetic Spacers

FIRST INSTALL THE ASTRAGAL TO THE DOOR, making sure it is correctly positioned to ensure the L-shaped protector plate does not interfere with the deadlatch.

To install the L-shaped steel protector plate onto the frame face using the interlocking astragal magnetic spacers:

- 1. Attach the four spacers at equal distances along the length of the plate. The magnets will hold them in place.
- 2. Place the steel protector plate onto the frame and close the astragal over the plate and spacers.
- 3. Move the plate up or down to set the correct height.
- 4. Run a self-tapping sheet metal screw through the pre-drilled holes at the top and bottom of the plate.
- 5. Before opening the door, drill a hole and install a screw at the approximate centre line between the top and bottom of the plate. This will secure the correct position of plates that may be warped.
- 6. Open the door and remove the magnetic spacers.
- 7. Test the door to make sure it operates correctly and secure the plate onto the frame using heavy duty rivets as suggested by the manufacturer.
